- 818,361 In a commendable effort to address immediate needs, We have provided emergency food and clothing to 818,361 individuals. This vital support has offered crucial relief to those facing hardship, ensuring they have access to basic necessities during challenging times.
- **3,288,475** Amidst growing need, we have distributed an impressive **3,288,475** emergency food boxes. This substantial effort has played a crucial role in ensuring that individuals and families facing hardship have access to essential nutrition during challenging times.
- **37,912** In response to the pressing need for shelter during extreme weather conditions, our Code Blue Shelter has provided refuge to **37,912** individuals. Through this vital initiative, we have offered a safe and warm environment for those facing homelessness, ensuring they have protection from harsh elements.
