A word from Madelyn Sutton Director of the Christian Caring Center

Judges 6:12 "When the angel of the Lord appeared to Gideon, he said, "The Lord is with you, mighty warrior".

Most of us want to know the will of God for our lives, but sometimes we're not always sure how to find it. Fortunately, the Bible points to a kind of guidance that does not put our current projects in jeopardy. In the Bible, there are descriptions of how God completely immersed Himself in the challenge of the moment. A good example of this is in Gideon's life. Gideon had limited vision, but he was committed to it. His challenge was to obtain food for his family, even though hostile invaders were making the growing, gathering and preparation of food almost impossible. I see everyday families, seniors, homeless coming into our pantry, community lunch and even on street outreach committed to getting food for their household. Many don't want to be there, but they have no choice. They are committed. Some come daily to have their only hot meal of the day.

Some come in cars for a box of food that will sustain them for 6 days. Some we meet on the street wandering through the town. Some are looking for us and others we look for them to feed them lunch. All of you are like Gideon, a mighty warrior for the Lord and for our clients. You are the selected 300 in our Army fighting against the invaders of hunger homelessness. You are the Army of God that supplies the needs of the Christian Caring Center as we provide: food, case managers who help people with homeless prevention by catching up on late rent payments, helping someone who is homeless get into a new apartment, find a new job, reunite with family, help someone with no heat, or a large utility bill, a warm winter coat, take a shower, get clothing, etc. This help is monumental when someone is in need. It's a life changer. It also provides us an opportunity to pray and share the Gospel with our guest, which is the real-life changer for Eternity. We do all this in love. EMERGENCY FOOD PROGRAM

The **Lord** through Christian Caring Center helped 828 adults and 346 children totaling 1174 individuals or 444 households with meals in the month of February, 2024- PTL!!!

COMMUNITY LUNCH/RURAL HOMELESS PROGRAM

The **Lord** through the Christian Caring Center served 637 hot cooked lunches and 232 continental breakfasts for a total of 869 meals in the month of February, 2024. We also go out to the streets/woods on Wednesday and Friday to deliver 50 lunches and outreach to the homeless, alcoholic, addicted or mentally challenged men, women in 2 area motels. The Red Carpet is shut down for repairs and all guests are being relocated currently. Please continue to pray for the people still out there homeless and struggling as well as the staff and volunteers.

SALVATION ARMY SERVICE UNIT AND GRANTS FOR FEBRUARY 2024:

The Christian Caring Center serves as a volunteer service unit for the Salvation Army. They placed 5 individuals into motels and helped 3 families with utility assistance.

SSH helped 4 families with utilities, 3 families with Security Deposits and 2 people with back rent.

MEN'S EMERGENCY SHELTER PROGRAM

Jack Stelle Men's Emergency Shelter: We have 3 men in the shelter right now. Stan, Mitchell, and Stan are looking for work Mitchell has been going on interviews for a new job. We are asking for your prayers for all the men.

<u>Holman House</u>: Is temporarily closed to residents right now as we are going through renovations of adding a bathroom and bedroom for an isolation room.

Marion House: Our mom has been reunited with family. We have a new family, mom and 5 children, coming in February. Mom is looking for work. Please pray for them as they look for permanent housing.

CODE BLUE SHELTER:

We have held 72 nights so far. Most nights are full with 14 guests. The Caring Center has continued to be a leader in blessing individuals and families all because your generosity and we are grateful! You share in the testimony of the love that God has for His people, which gives us an opportunity to share the Gospel, pray with people and love them. We can not thank you enough!
